Scholars will presumably be accommodated in double rooms.

A full scholarship of € 750 will be granted primarily to undergraduate and graduate students. Participants will have to contribute € 150 themselves.

A partial scholarship of € 450 will be granted to those who are capable of financing part of the participation fee themselves. € 450 will have to be paid by the participant.
